LOCATION OF RANGE

ISSF: Registered with SFC

Connaught Range is located near the Ottawa River, west of Shirley's Bay. From Hwy. 417 (Exit 134), drive north on Moodie Drive 1.7 km. to Hwy 17B; left (west) from Moodie Drive to Rifle Road 2.6 km; turn right (north) on Rifle Road 2 km to Shirley's Bay; left (west) on Malabar to Enfield Road right to Shirley Blvd Right to range. Outdoor pistol ranges.

ENTRIES

Matches open to ALL competitors. Advance entries requested and may be confirmed if first choice is not possible. If a competitor is unable to attend and has not notified the Registrar prior to the match, their registration fee may not be refunded.

SCORING, CLASSIFICATIONS & AWARDS

Scoring will be done by the competitors. Signature of competitor will make the score final on the score card.

Highest current classification card must be shown for all events except Slug Gun events. For ISSF events, please use your current Shooting Federation of Canada (SFC) classification where possible. CSSA or similar classifications may be used if you do not have an SFC classification, as well as for the Canadian 1800 (NRA) or for PPC. Those competitors without a classification card will be entered as Unclassified (Temporary Expert for ISSF and CDN events and as Temporary Master for the PPC events). A competitor may pay for and shoot an event more than once but only the first score will count. Additional scores will be treated as practice only.

Each competitor will receive a souvenir and a post-match bulletin.

There is one open award for each event. MASTER will shoot for open awards only. Awards will be given to each class with 7 or more competitors. Class with less than 7 may be grouped with the next higher class. If not sufficient competitors, awards will be in cash.

Accommodations: barracks accommodations may be available for this match. Call to confirm.

EYE and EAR protection are mandatory. Match rules and procedures are per NRA, CPCA and ISSF rules, as interpreted by the Match Committee.

For those that require an ATT to attend DND ranges a phone call to the CFO's office at I-800-731-4000 as early as possible should solve this. I is for English, 3 is for ATTs.

Note that your PAL attached ATT terms do NOT allow for transportation of restricted firearms to DND ranges. Obtain a short-term ATT.

^{**9}mm Service Pistol: shooters bring their own pistol (9mm semi-automatic service pistol) and 60 rounds of factory 9mm FMJ ammunition. The match is fired at 25 metres at the Figure 11 (charging man) target.
