2020 Ontario Winter Games Trials Selection Criteria

The 2020 Ontario Winter Games 10m air rifle and 10m air pistol shooting events are being hosted by the City of Orillia and our competitions will take place February 27 - 29, 2020 at the Rama MASK sport venue consisting of one individual 10m air rifle/air pistol match and one combined team match for Junior athletes only with a formal Opening Ceremonies .

To be eligible for these Gamesa Junior athlete must be an Ontario resident and of the age of at least 12 years old in the year 2020 with your 21st birthday being after December 31, 2020 to qualify (athletes must be able to compete free standing, no benchrests under ISSF Rules). The athlete must also be a current member in good standing of ONTarget: Rifle and Pistol Alliance if such athlete accepts a team spot.

Trials for these Games will be conducted this year in conjunction with the December 7/8, 2019 and January 11/12, 2020 LSBA matches at all locations being offered for these specific matches (see LSBA bulletin for more information regarding these matches, locations and registration details). The trials for air rifle and air pistol will consist of 60 shots for both males & females. Should scores be submitted from electronics, they will be converted before ranking using the SFC standard conversion calculation.

The top 4 males and top 4 females in each of the Trials for each discipline of air rifle & air pistol will be selected to compete in the Ontario WinterGames (total of 8 rifle & 8 pistol athletes). Any athlete can submit as many scores as they wish but only their highest score per discipline will be used to determine their ranking for qualification purposes. Each athlete's highest score per discipline will be taken and entered on a list in order of highest to lowest score and the first 4 males and the first 4 females highest scores in each discipline will be invited to participate in the Ontario Winter Games. The remainder of the listed athletes in each discipline will be considered alternates and will be contacted on an individual basis, in the order of ranking on the list, should an athlete with a higher score decide not to participate. If there are not enough qualified athletes in one of the disciplines, athletes from the other discipline may be substituted following gender equality at the discretion of ONTarget.

To compete in the trials please fill out the attached Qualification form that accompanies this selection criteria (print your own or available at the registration desk) which must be submitted to your location's LSBA match director prior to competition. The match director at your location will calculate your scores and forward it to ONTarget following the match. All applications must be received by January 14, 2020. Team List will be published on or before January 16, 2019.

NOTE: There is no fee for the trials. If you wish toenter the Trials without fully competing in the Dec or Jan LSBA's there is no charge to compete once per discipline/per event (i.e. 1 x Air event on one of dates at Dec LSBA and 1 x Air event on of the dates at Jan LSBA), however your score will not be eligible for awards at such match and/or for classification purposes. Any further entries after the initial free entry at either the Dec or Jan LSBA must be paid for as a regular entry.
