Senior Applicants: 4 of the 5 need to equal or exceed the SFC Development Team Cut Score; Junior Applicants: 3 of the 5 need to equal or exceed the SFC Junior Team Cut Score. • A minimum of 3 match scores must be submitted for consideration - AWAD: 3 scores that equal or exceed SFC NAST; AWAD Jr: 2 scores that equal or exceed SFC NAST. • Any competition conducted under ISSF rules and officiated by a certified official will qualify, including LSBA, games trials, nationals, provincials (any province), international competitions, etc. as outlined • Competition must have been held between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019 • <u>Application, training plan and score sheet must be submitted by 11:59 pm EST, March 2, 2020</u> <p style="text-align: center;">Please refer to the 2019 Quest for Gold Athlete Selection Criteria document for more detailed information on the complete selection criteria. 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To be eligible for OAAP consideration:

- Adult athletes must shoot and submit at least four (4) out of the five (5) scores that must be equal to or greater than the current SFC National Team Development Cut Score. The following year the performance level may increase.
- Junior athletes must shoot and submit at least three (3) out of the five (5) scores that must be equal to or greater than the current SFC National Team Junior Cut Score. The following year, the performance level may increase.
- Adult athletes with a disability (AWAD) must shoot and submit a minimum of three (3) scores that must be equal to or greater than the current SFC National Adaptive Team Development Cut Score (NAST). The following year the performance level may increase.
- Junior athletes with a disability (AWAD) must shoot and submit a minimum of two (2) scores that must be equal to or greater than the current SFC National Adaptive Team Cut Score (NAST). The following year, the performance level may increase.

- **If you are submitting a mix of decimal and whole number scores, you will need to show all of your scores in both formats in order for the committee to determine ranking.** The current process is that paper scores (whole numbers) are being converted to decimal scores by the standard formula (multiply by 1.045). This formula is the SFC's accepted standard and follows the same process as it's been for several years now and has not changed.
