I am pleased to share some exciting news regarding additional funding to support Ontario Council of Shooters, Inc. for 2021-2022.

Our Ministry recognizes the past two years have been incredibly challenging as we have had to navigate through this unprecedented time together, including multiple instances of closures to the facilities that house the activities your organization and member clubs deliver.

I am pleased to tell you that Ontario Council of Shooters, Inc. is eligible to receive up to \$225,316.77 of provincial funding, to be dispersed in support of your member clubs across the province.

COVID-19 has halted many programs and training in the last two years, making ranking of athletes an impossibility for many organizations. In light of these circumstances, **for 2021-22 only**, funding will be provided to PSOs who will be responsible for determining whether to provide direct athlete assistance or support high performance programming operated by the PSO. As such, Ontario Council of Shooters, Inc. is eligible to receive up to \$31,196.00 in Quest for Gold Ontario Card funding. Details regarding eligible costs related to this funding will be communicated to you through ministry staff.
