The 2024 Outdoor Provincial Smallbore Championships will be held at Cookstown, Ontario at the Lou Anderson Centre, Toronto International Trap and Skeet Club. As in 2019, the Outdoor Championships will be completed in one day. ISSF events in the AM and Sporting Rifle Prone and Hunting Rifle in the PM. THERE WILL BE NO SPORTING RIFLE 3POS due to continued low entries again this winter LSBA competition season. ISSF events and Sporting Rifle events will be conducted on the Megalink Electronic Target System. The Hunting Rifle event will be using paper targets for their competition.

Advanced entry may be sent directly to the Match Director and payment may be made directly to the ONTarget secretary using an EMT. Please enter early to guarantee a spot and help the organizers run the match as smoothly as possible. All match entries received before Aug 15 will receive acknowledgement of entry via email if address is given.

**Junior Shooters:** in Sporting Rifle Prone, medals will be awarded to **Junior** and **Intermediate Jr's**. In line with SFC rules, a Sporting Rifle Junior is a shooter who has not reached his/her 16<sup>th</sup> birthday as of Dec 31, 2024. An Intermediate Junior is a Sporting Rifle Junior who has not reached his/her 21<sup>st</sup> birthday by Dec 31, 2024. In ISSF events, an **International Junior** is a shooter who has not reached his/her birthday by Dec 31, 2024. **Juniors must indicate date of birth on their entry form.**

We are including a Veteran category in Sporting and ISSF events. A veteran is a shooter is a shooter who has reached his 55<sup>th</sup> birthday as of Dec 31, 2024.

**Equipment Check** - Sporting Rifle. Total weight should not be over 4kg. Trigger not < 1kg.  
Spot checks will be made on the firing line.

- ISSF events. As per ISSF rules, there will be random check on the firing line.

IT IS THE SHOOTERS RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE HIS/HER EQUIPMENT COMPLIES WITH THE RULES. IF THE COMPETITOR HAS ANY DOUBT ABOUT ANY PIECE OF EQUIPMENT, PLEASE ALERT THE RANGE STAFF BEFORE THE EVENT BEGINS.

## Championships Schedule

Registration for ISSF events will be at 0830 on Saturday morning. For afternoon events registration will be at 12:30

Competitors are reminded that they must be on hand ahead of scheduled starting time to allow registration and set-up of equipment. One half before hand is recommended. The matches will start on time. Vacancies maybe filled with post entries.

**EVENTS:** all at 50 meters. ISSF and Sporting Rifle Prone on Electronic Target. Hunting Rifle on be shot on paper targets.

ISSF Prone : iron sights, 60 shots ( M, EX, SS, MM VT, IJ )

ISSF 3 Position : men and women, 20 shots in kneeling, prone, standing ( M, EX,SS MM VT, IJ )

Sporting Rifle Prone : 60 shot, 3x20 ( M, EX, SS, MM, VT, IJ, JR )

Hunting Rifle : 60 shots. ( Open, IJ )

**AWARDS :** A Provincial Champion plaque ( Cdn citizens only ) will be awarded to the top shooter in each event. Winners of these awards are ineligible for classification awards in corresponding event. Medals will be awarded in each category. Seconds will be awarded in all classes with 3 or more competitors, thirds will be awarded with 6 or more in each classification. ( we reserve the right to combine classes if a match has one class with only one or two competitors.)

### Rule and Classifications:

- ISSF and SFC rules and classifications will apply in all matches
- shooters without a current classification will compete as EXPERTS or MASTERS.
- in line with current SFC rules Sporting Rifle Jr's as mentioned above.
- as with Indoor Championships all competitors must be members of ONTarget Rifle and Pistol Alliance or the Federation Quebecoise de Tir. Membership in the SFC is not mandatory but is strongly recommended. Membership in ONTarget maybe obtained online at the following address: <http://ontariotarget.ca/register>
- time limits : ISSF Prone 50 min, ISSF 3 Position 90 min, Sporting Rifle 30min per 20 shots. Hunting Rifle 30min per 20 shots.

Match Entry Fees All ISSF and Sporting Rifle 60 shot events **\$45.** for adults. **\$20.** for Juniors  
Hunting Rifle event **\$25.** for adults. **\$10** for Juniors. Take 5\$ off for 2<sup>nd</sup> event.  
( for Juniors to be eligible for Class awards, full fee will be required. )
